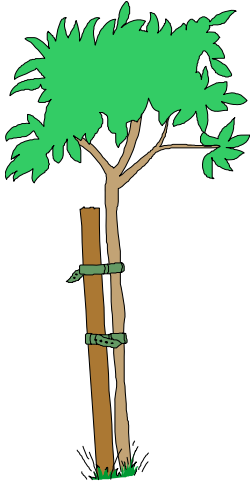

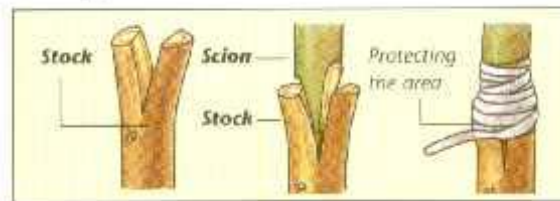

Grafting is a method to use for:

1. saving or propagating a "heritage" or older type of fruit tree that cannot be found anymore.
2. the challenge of propagating a favorite fruit tree and giving it away to family or friends.
3. a method to establish more trees of the same type for personal use.

The grafting shown can be done for either apple or pear trees.
